- **(D)** DAMAGES AWARDED BY A COURT UNDER SUBSECTION (C)(1) OF THIS SECTION MAY BE EQUAL TO THREE TIMES THE AMOUNT OF ACTUAL DAMAGES.
- **(E)** THIS SECTION DOES NOT AFFECT ANY LEGAL OR EQUITABLE RIGHT OR 29 REMEDY OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY LAW.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect on or application to any cause of action arising before the effective date of this Act.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 5 October 1, 2021.
