 4 CONDITIONING-RELATED ACTIVITY;

- 6 (III) AN INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETIC ACTIVITY; OR
- 7 (IV) A PHYSICAL EDUCATION PROGRAM.
- 8 (3) "TACKLE FOOTBALL SEASON" MEANS THE TIME PERIOD EACH
 9 YEAR IN WHICH TACKLE FOOTBALL GAMES MAY BE PLAYED BY A STUDENT OR MADE

- 4 (II) BY A RECREATIONAL ATHLETIC ORGANIZATION.
- 5 (5) "YOUTH SPORTS PROGRAM" MEANS A PROGRAM ORGANIZED FOR
- 6 TACKLE FOOTBALL-RELATED RECREATIONAL ATHLETIC COMPETITION OR 7 INSTRUCTION FOR PARTICIPANTS WHO ARE UNDER THE AGE OF 14 YEARS.
- 8 (B) EACH ANNUAL TACKLE FOOTBALL SEASON SHALL BE LIMITED TO THE 9 MONTHS OF AUGUST THROUGH DECEMBER.
- 10 (C) A YOUTH SPORTS PROGRAM MAY NOT PROVIDE TACKLE FOOTBALL 11 GAMES FOR YOUTH ATHLETES DURING THE MONTHS OF JANUARY THROUGH JULY.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 13 1, 2020.
