- FOR the purpose of requiring each assisted living program to provide its residents with educational material on the influenza virus on or before a certain date each year; requiring that the educational material include certain information; prohibiting an assisted living program from being required to pay for or provide an influenza virus vaccine, unless otherwise required by law; and generally relating to educational material on the influenza virus provided by assisted living program facilities.
