(b) 3 "Education loan" means any loan that is obtained for tuition, educational (c) expenses, or living expenses for undergraduate or graduate study leading to practice 4 as a physician OR PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT. 5 6 (d) "Fund" means the Maryland Loan Assistance Repayment Program Fund. "Eligible field of employment" includes employment by the State or

- The Office shall assist in the repayment with the funds transferred to the 1 (b) 2 Office by the Comptroller under § 14–207(c)(2)(i) of the Health Occupations Article of 3 the amount of education loans owed by a physician **OR PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT** who:
- 4 (1) Practices primary care in an eligible field of employment in a geographic area of the State that has been federally designated; or
 - (ii) Is a medical resident specializing in primary care who agrees to practice for at least 2 years as a primary care physician in an eligible field of employment in a geographic area of the State that has been federally designated; and
- 9 Meets any other requirements established by the Office, in consultation with the Department. 10
- 11 Any unspent portions of the money that is transferred to the Office for 12 use under this subtitle from the Board of Physicians Fund may not be transferred to or 13 revert to the General Fund of the State, but shall remain in the Fund maintained by 14 the Office to administer the Program.

- 16 In addition to the assistance provided under § 18–2804 of this subtitle, 17 the Office may, subject to the availability of money in the Fund, assist in the repayment of an education loan owed by a physician OR PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT who: 18
- 19 (1) Practices a medical specialty that has been identified by the 20 Department as being in shortage in the geographic area of the State where the 21physician OR PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT practices that specialty; and
- 22 Commits to practicing in the area for a period of time determined **(2)** 23by the Office.
- 24The Office shall prioritize funding for the repayment of education loans 25through the Program in the following order:
- 26 (1) Physicians AND PHYSICIAN ASSISTANTS the that meet 27requirements under § 18–2804(b) of this subtitle;
- 28 Physicians AND PHYSICIAN ASSISTANTS practicing primary care 29 in a geographic area where the Department has identified a shortage of primary care 30 physicians OR PHYSICIAN ASSISTANTS; and
- 31 Physicians AND PHYSICIAN ASSISTANTS practicing a medical (3)specialty other than primary care in a geographic area where the Department has 3233 identified a shortage of that specialty.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2014.
