A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Baltimore County - School Board Nominating Commission - Vacancy Procedures

FOR the purpose of requiring the Baltimore County School Board Nominating Commission 4 $\mathbf{5}$ to hold a public hearing on the selection of a nominee for a single vacancy on the 6 Baltimore County Board of Education in a certain manner under certain 7 circumstances; requiring the Commission to make publicly available on its website 8 live video streaming of certain public hearings and certain archived video recordings; 9 authorizing the Commission to retain and reactivate the applications of certain candidates for certain vacancies on the county board; authorizing the Commission to 1011 reactivate certain applications under certain circumstances; making conforming 12changes; and generally relating to vacancy procedures and the Baltimore County School Board Nominating Commission. 13

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 24 (2) The purpose of the Commission is to select nominees to be 25 recommended to the Governor as qualified candidates for appointment to the Baltimore

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July1, 2021.
