- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring certain county boards of education seeking State funds for 5 the construction of a new school, or the renovation of or an addition to an existing 6 school that would increase the capacity by more than a certain number of students, 7 to submit a pedestrian safety plan to the Interagency Commission on School 8 Construction under certain circumstances; requiring the Interagency Commission to 9 review the pedestrian safety plans in consultation with the State Highway Administration; providing for the contents of a pedestrian safety plan; authorizing 10 11 the Interagency Commission to adopt regulations to carry out this Act; defining 12 certain terms; and generally relating to pedestrian safety plans for schools.

- 11 INPUT RELATED TO THE PEDESTRIAN SAFETY PLAN INCLUDING MINUTES FROM A
- 12 PUBLIC HEARING AND WRITTEN COMMENTS.
- 13 (D) THE INTERAGENCY COMMISSION MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY 14 OUT THIS SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 16 1, 2021.
