- 8 (b) This section applies to the following persons:
- 9 (1) an applicant for a video lottery operation license **OR SPORTS** 10 **WAGERING LICENSE**;
- 11 (2) a holder of a video lottery operation license **OR SPORTS WAGERING** 12 **LICENSE**; [or]
- 13 (3) a person who owns an interest in the operation of **ONLINE SPORTS**
- 14 WAGERING, a video lottery facility, OR A SPORTS WAGERING FACILITY in [this] THE
- 15 State; OR
- 16 (4) AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER EMPLOYED BY A VIDEO LOTTERY OPERATOR OR SPORTS WAGERING LICENSEE IN THE STATE.
- 18 (c) This section does not apply to gaming activity that an eligible organization is 19 authorized to conduct under the Criminal Law Article.
- 20 (d) A person subject to this section may not, directly or indirectly, make a 21 contribution to:
- 22 (1) the campaign finance entity of a candidate for any nonfederal public 23 office in the State; or
- 24 (2) any other campaign finance entity organized in support of a candidate 25 for any nonfederal public office in the State.
