- 2 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 3 INDICATED.
- 4 (2) (I) "CONCRETE BATCHING PLANT" MEANS A FACILITY USED TO 5 PRODUCE CONCRETE BY MIXING AGGREGATE WITH CEMENT.
- 6 (II) "CONCRETE BATCHING PLANT" INCLUDES STRUCTURES
  7 USED TO STOCKPILE BULK MATERIALS REQUIRED FOR THE PROCESS OR TO STORE
  8 EQUIPMENT REQUIRED FOR USE IN THE PRODUCTION OF CONCRETE.
- 9 (3) "SETBACK DISTANCE" MEANS THE DISTANCE MEASURED FROM
  10 THE CONCRETE BATCHING PLANT, INCLUDING ANY LOCATION ON THE PROPERTY
  11 THAT IS USED FOR THE PRODUCTION OF CONCRETE, TO ANY RESIDENTIAL BUILDING
  12 IN ALL DIRECTIONS.
- 13 (B) EACH CONCRETE BATCHING PLANT APPROVED FOR CONSTRUCTION ON OR AFTER OCTOBER 1, 2021, SHALL COMPLY WITH A MINIMUM SETBACK DISTANCE EQUAL TO NOT LESS THAN 1,000 FEET.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2021.
