17 18	(1) TO AN EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT OR A SIMILAR DOCUMENT OR AGREEMENT CONCERNING AN EMPLOYEE WHO EARNS EQUAL TO OR LESS THAN:
19	(I) \$15 PER HOUR; OR
20	(II) \$31,200 ANNUALLY; AND

- 1 (2) WHETHER OR NOT THE EMPLOYER AND EMPLOYEE ENTERED INTO 2 THE EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT OR SIMILAR DOCUMENT OR AGREEMENT IN THE 3 STATE.
- 4 (B) A NONCOMPETE OR CONFLICT OF INTEREST PROVISION IN AN 5 EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT OR A SIMILAR DOCUMENT OR AGREEMENT THAT 6 RESTRICTS THE ABILITY OF AN EMPLOYEE TO ENTER INTO EMPLOYMENT WITH A NEW EMPLOYER OR TO BECOME SELF-EMPLOYED IN THE SAME OR SIMILAR BUSINESS OR TRADE SHALL BE NULL AND VOID AS BEING AGAINST THE PUBLIC POLICY OF THE STATE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 11 October 1, 2017.
