- 1 (1) the purchaser falsely represented [in writing and supported] with 2 [other] documentary evidence that the purchaser was of legal age to purchase alcoholic 3 beverages;
- 4 (2) on the basis of the appearance of the purchaser, an ordinary and 5 prudent individual would believe the purchaser to be of legal age to purchase alcoholic 6 beverages; and
- 7 (3) the sale was made in good faith and in reliance on the [written] FALSE 8 representation and appearance of the purchaser.
- 9 (B) THE RELIANCE BY AN ESTABLISHMENT OR A SELLER ON THE RESULTS
 10 OF AN ELECTRONIC IDENTIFICATION SCANNER THAT VERIFIES THE IDENTITY OF AN
 11 INDIVIDUAL BY BARCODE OR SIMILARLY RELIABLE IDENTIFICATION TECHNOLOGY
 12 CONSTITUTES REASONABLE AND GOOD FAITH RELIANCE ON THE REPRESENTATION
 13 OF THE PURCHASER UNDER SUBSECTION (A)(3) OF THIS SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 15 1, 2019.
