1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Office of Cemetery Oversight – Preneed Burial Contracts – Report Submission**
3 **Requirement**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the time period within which a certain seller of preneed goods
5 or preneed services is required to submit a certain report regarding preneed burial
6 contracts and preneed trust accounts to the Director of the Office of Cemetery
7 Oversight; and generally relating to preneed burial contracts and the Office of
8 Cemetery Oversight.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
20 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article – Business Regulation**

2 (a) (1) Each seller shall keep detailed records of all preneed burial contracts
3 and specific funds.

4 (2) The records of each seller and of each trustee appointed by the seller
5 are subject to examination by:

6 (i) the Director;

7 (ii) the Attorney General or an authorized representative of the
8 Attorney General; and

9 (iii) the State's Attorney for the county where the seller does
10 business.

11 (b) (1) Each seller subject to the trust requirements of this subtitle shall
12 submit a report to the Director within [120] ~~180~~ 150 days after the close of each calendar
13 or other fiscal year chosen by the seller.

14 (2) The report shall:

15 (i) be on the form that the Director requires;

16 (ii) be certified by a certified public accountant retained by the seller;

17 (iii) be accompanied by a trustee's annual summary statement of
18 assets from the trustee for the reporting period which includes:

19 1. the amount of money in the preneed trust fund at the
20 beginning of the reporting period;

21 2. an investment portfolio summary describing the asset and
22 the market value for each investment class;

23 3. a transaction summary of the preneed trust fund
24 containing:

25 A. trust account earnings;

26 B. money deposited;

27 C. total receipts;

28 D. administrative expenses;

1 E. withdrawals from the trust account for canceled contracts;

2 F. withdrawals from the trust account for delivery of
3 merchandise for use or storage, and for services performed, including the principal and
4 earnings;

5 G. other disbursements; and

6 H. total disbursements; and

7 4. the amount of money in the preneed trust fund at the end
8 of the reporting period;

9 (iv) be accompanied by a fee of \$25; and

10 (v) include:

11 1. the name of the seller;

12 2. each location of the seller;

13 3. the amount of money that the seller received during that
14 year that is subject to the trust requirements of this subtitle;

15 4. the amount of money actually deposited into trust
16 accounts in that year;

17 5. the amount of money required to be disbursed from the
18 trust accounts in that year;

19 6. the amount of money actually disbursed from the trust
20 accounts in that year; and

21 7. the name and address of the trustee.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
23 October 1, 2015.
