## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Board of Education – Study on the Use of Prefabricated School**  
3 **Construction**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Board of Education to conduct a certain study  
5 on the use of prefabricated school construction in Maryland; requiring the State  
6 Board of Education to report to the General Assembly on or before a certain  
7 date; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to a study  
8 on the use of prefabricated school construction in the State by the State Board  
9 of Education.

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
11 MARYLAND, That:

12 (a) The State Board of Education shall conduct a study on the feasibility,  
13 advantages, disadvantages, and potential savings of the use of prefabricated school  
14 construction in Maryland; and

15 (b) On or before December 31, 2012, the State Board of Education shall  
16 report to the General Assembly, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government  
17 Article, on the use of prefabricated school construction in Maryland.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
19 June 1, 2012. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and, at the end of May 31,  
20 2013, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be  
21 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
