A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Public Ethics - Former Legislators - Lobbying

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a former member of the General Assembly from assisting 4 or representing another party for compensation in a matter that is the subject of 5 legislative action until the later of the conclusion of the next regular session that 6 begins after the member leaves office or 6 months after the date that the campaign 7 finance entity of the member makes a transfer to another campaign committee; and 8 generally relating to public ethics, former legislators, and lobbying.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. 14
- 15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - General Provisions 16

- 17 5-504.
- 18 Except for a former member of the General Assembly, who shall be 19 subject to the restrictions provided under paragraph (2) of this subsection, a former official 20 or employee may not assist or represent a party, other than the State, in a case, a contract,
- 21 or any other specific matter for compensation if:
- 22 (i) the matter involves State government; and
- 23 the former official or employee participated significantly in the 24matter as an official or employee.

1	(2) (i) Except as provided in subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, [until
2	the conclusion of the next regular session that begins after the member leaves office,] a
3	former member of the General Assembly may not assist or represent another party for
4	compensation in a matter that is the subject of legislative action UNTIL THE LATER OF:

- 5 1. THE CONCLUSION OF THE NEXT REGULAR SESSION 6 THAT BEGINS AFTER THE MEMBER LEAVES OFFICE; OR
- 7 2. 6 MONTHS AFTER THE DATE THAT THE CAMPAIGN 8 FINANCE ENTITY OF THE MEMBER MAKES A TRANSFER TO ANOTHER CAMPAIGN 9 FINANCE ENTITY.
- 10 (ii) The limitation under subparagraph (i) of this paragraph on 11 representation by a former member of the General Assembly does not apply to the former 12 member's representation of a municipal corporation, county, or State governmental entity.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2015.
