- 3 FOR the purpose of altering the period within which a certain sex offender registrant is
- 4 required to notify each local law enforcement unit where the registrant resides or
- 5 habitually lives before the registrant leaves the United States to commence residence
- or employment or attend school in a foreign country; and generally relating to sex
- 7 offenders.

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 17 (h) A registrant shall notify each local law enforcement unit where the registrant
- 18 resides or habitually lives at least [3] 21 days prior to leaving the United States to
- 19 commence residence or employment or attend school in a foreign country.
