1 AN ACT concerning

Natural Resources – Licenses, Permits, Registrations, and Certificates – Digital or Electronic Format

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Natural Resources to make available and, $\mathbf{5}$ on request, issue certain licenses, permits, registrations, and certificates in a digital 6 or electronic format; establishing that an individual may satisfy certain 7 requirements to possess or display a license, permit, registration, or certificate by 8 possessing or displaying the document in a certain digital or electronic format; 9 requiring the Department to design certain digital or electronic documents in a certain manner; and generally relating to licenses, permits, registrations, and 10 11 certificates issued by the Department of Natural Resources.

- 22 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 23 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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1 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this article, the Department may 2 develop and implement an electronic system for the sale and issuance of licenses, permits, 3 and registrations and the recording and releasing of security interests.

- 4 (b) The electronic system may include provisions for: $\mathbf{5}$ (1)Recording titling and registration data; 6 (2)Recording and releasing liens without the issuance of a security interest 7filing; and Recording information relating to an application for a license, permit, 8 (3)9 or registration. 10 The Department shall develop the electronic system consistent with the (c) statewide information technology master plan developed under Title 3A, Subtitle 3 of the 11 12State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 13 (g) The Department may adopt regulations to:

- (1) Implement the electronic system authorized under this section; and

15 (2) Determine the appropriate fee levels that may be charged by a vendor 16 and by the Department for the electronic transmission service.

18 (A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL MAKE AVAILABLE AND, ON REQUEST, ISSUE 19 ANY LICENSE, PERMIT, REGISTRATION, OR CERTIFICATE AUTHORIZED UNDER THIS 20 ARTICLE IN A DIGITAL OR ELECTRONIC FORMAT.

(B) (1) AN INDIVIDUAL MAY SATISFY ANY REQUIREMENT UNDER THIS
ARTICLE TO POSSESS OR DISPLAY A LICENSE, PERMIT, REGISTRATION, OR
CERTIFICATE BY POSSESSING OR DISPLAYING THE DOCUMENT IN A DIGITAL OR
ELECTRONIC FORMAT AS PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT.

(2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DESIGN THE DIGITAL OR ELECTRONIC
DOCUMENTS AUTHORIZED UNDER THIS SECTION IN A MANNER THAT ALLOWS THE
DOCUMENT HOLDER TO MAINTAIN PHYSICAL POSSESSION OF THE DEVICE ON WHICH
THE DOCUMENT IS ACCESSED DURING VERIFICATION.
