SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
Article - Education

5-219.
(A) THE HEAD Start Program in the State shall be referred to as the Ulysses Currie Head Start Program.
