A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George's County – National Harbor – Alcoholic Beverages –**
3 **Restriction on License Holder**

5 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the issuance of a certain Class C beer, wine and liquor
6 license for use in the National Harbor in Prince George's County to the same
7 organization for a certain number of consecutive years; and generally relating to
8 alcoholic beverages in Prince George's County.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

22 7–101.

23 (x) (1) This subsection applies only in Prince George's County.

1 (2) The Board of License Commissioners may issue a special 3–day
2 Class C beer, wine and liquor license to a nonprofit organization that is exempt from
3 taxation under § 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

4 (3) The special license entitles the holder to sell beer, wine, or liquor
5 at the National Harbor.

6 (6) The special license may not be issued to any one organization for:

7 **(I)** [more] **MORE** than 3 consecutive days in a single calendar
8 year; **OR**

9 **(II)** **2 CONSECUTIVE YEARS.**

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
11 July 1, 2010.
