#### 1 AN ACT concerning

## Public Safety – Fire, Rescue, or Emergency Medical Services Entities – Peer Support Programs

FOR the purpose of establishing certain confidentiality requirements for peer support
counseling programs for fire, rescue, or emergency medical services entities;
requiring the Behavioral Health Administration to issue a report on certain best
practices relating to peer support counseling for fire, rescue, or emergency medical
services entities and to make certain information regarding peer support counseling
publicly available on the Administration's website; and generally relating to peer
support programs for fire, rescue, or emergency medical services entities.
