- (C) "VETERAN" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO SERVED ON ACTIVE DUTY IN THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES, OTHER THAN FOR TRAINING, AND WAS DISCHARGED OR RELEASED UNDER CONDITIONS OTHER THAN DISHONORABLE.
- 4 **(D)** "VETERAN-OWNED small business enterprise" means a SMALL business that is [verified by the Center for Veterans Enterprise of the United States Department of Veterans Affairs as a veteran-owned small business] AT LEAST 51% OWNED BY ONE OR MORE INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE VETERANS.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2017.
