1 AN ACT concerning

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Child Care Centers - Teacher Qualifications

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the regulations adopted by the State Board of Education to govern the licensing and operation of child care centers to include provisions that 4 establish certain qualifications for probationary employment for a certain individual 5 to be a child care teacher in a certain child care center; requiring that the 6 7 probationary employment qualifications allow an individual to be employed as a 8 child care teacher in a probationary period under certain circumstances; requiring a 9 child care center to terminate or reassign a certain individual to a nonteaching 10 position under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the qualifications of child care center teachers. 11

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 2 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 3 Article - Education 9.5-404. 4 The State Board shall adopt rules and regulations for licensing and operating 5 (a) 6 child care centers. 7 (b) These rules and regulations shall: 8 Require a child care center to have a written emergency preparedness plan for emergency situations that require evacuation, sheltering in place, or 9 other protection of children, such as in the event of fire, natural disaster, or other 10 threatening situation that may pose a health or safety hazard to the children in the child 11 12 care center; 13 (ii) Require the plan under item (i) of this item to include: A designated relocation site and evacuation route; 14 1. 15 2.
