- 21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 22 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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Article - Election Law

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- 3 (a) (1) There is a county board of elections in each county of the State.
- 4 (2) Each local board and its staff is subject to the direction and authority of the State Board and is accountable to the State Board for its actions in all matters regarding the implementation of the requirements of this article and any applicable federal law.
- 8 (b) (1) Except as provided in subsections (j), (k), and (l) of this section, 9 each local board consists of three regular members and two substitute members.
- 10 (2) Two regular members and one substitute member shall be of the 11 majority party, and one regular member and one substitute member shall be of the 12 principal minority party.
 - (3) Except as provided in subsection (l) of this section, in the event of the absence of a regular member or a vacancy in the office of a regular member, the substitute member of the same political party shall exercise the powers and duties of a regular member until the regular member returns or the vacancy is filled as prescribed in subsection (h) of this section.
- 18 (l) (1) In CHARLES COUNTY, SOMERSET COUNTY, Wicomico County, 19 AND Worcester County, [and Somerset County,] the local board consists of five regular 20 members.
- 21 (2) Three regular members shall be of the majority party, and two 22 regular members shall be of the principal minority party.
- 23 (3) (i) If a vacancy occurs on the local board, the Governor shall appoint an eligible person from the same political party as the predecessor member to fill the vacancy in accordance with subsection (g) of this section for the remainder of the unexpired term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- 27 (ii) An appointment made while the Senate of Maryland is not 28 in session shall be considered temporary until the appointee is confirmed by the 29 Senate.
 - SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1 June 6, 2011.
