18	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 1 (A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH AND ADMINISTER A STATEWIDE 2 GREEN BUSINESS CERTIFICATION PROGRAM.
- 3 (B) THE GREEN BUSINESS CERTIFICATION PROGRAM SHALL:
- 4 (1) RECOGNIZE BUSINESSES THAT OPERATE IN A MANNER THAT 5 REDUCES THEIR ENVIRONMENTAL FOOTPRINT; AND
- 6 (2) PROVIDE CONSUMERS WITH A WAY TO IDENTIFY BUSINESSES 7 THAT HAVE BEEN CERTIFIED AS GREEN BUSINESSES.
- 8 (C) THE DEPARTMENT MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS 9 SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Department shall update and enhance the statewide green business certification program required under Section 1 of this Act in consultation with the Montgomery County Green Business Certification Program.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 15 1, 2021.
