1 AN ACT concerning

2 Public Utilities - Primary and Secondary Utility Account Holders - Domestic 3 Violence Victims of Abuse - Protections

- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring a certain utility to release a primary or secondary account holder who is the victim of domestic violence from a contract held with the utility 5 6 under certain circumstances authorizing an account holder who is the victim of abuse 7 to terminate, and requiring a utility to allow for the termination of, the account holder's future liability under a utility contract under certain circumstances; 8 9 requiring a utility to allow an account holder who terminates a utility contract under 10 this Act to allow the account holder to open a new utility account for a new premises 11 notwithstanding a certain account balance or arrearage; and generally relating to 12 public utility accounts.
