A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Rules of Interpretation – Interpretation of "Physician" – Inclusion of Advanced Practice Nurse and Physician Assistant

FOR the purpose of requiring that, under certain circumstances, the term "physician" be interpreted to include an "advanced practice nurse" and a "physician assistant"; prohibiting, under certain circumstances, a requirement for additional authorization of a unit of State government to endorse a document under the application of a certain provision of this Act; providing for the construction and application of this Act; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the interpretation of "physician" under State law.

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 1 – Rules of Interpretation

20 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE 21 MEANINGS INDICATED.

22 (2) "ADVANCED PRACTICE NURSE" HAS THE MEANING INDICATED 23 IN § 8–101 OF THE HEALTH – OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW. [Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



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1 (3) "PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT" HAS THE MEANING INDICATED IN § 2 15–101 OF THE HEALTH – OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE.

3 (4) "UNIT" MEANS A DEPARTMENT, AN AGENCY, A BOARD, AN
4 OFFICE OR ANY OTHER BODY IN STATE GOVERNMENT.

5 (B) THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED TO EXPAND THE SCOPE OF 6 PRACTICE OF AN ADVANCED PRACTICE NURSE OR A PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT.

7 IF A PROVISION OF STATE LAW OR AN IMPLEMENTING OR **(C)** 8 INTERPRETIVE TRANSMITTAL, NOTICE, FORM, POLICY, PROCEDURE, OR OTHER DOCUMENT PREPARED INCLUDING AN ORAL AUTHORIZATION THAT IS 9 DOCUMENTED, IN ACCORDANCE WITH STATE LAW, REQUIRES OR REFERS TO A 10 11 SIGNATURE, A CERTIFICATION, A VERIFICATION, AN AFFIDAVIT, OR ANY OTHER 12ENDORSEMENT BY A PHYSICIAN, THE TERM "PHYSICIAN" SHALL BE INTERPRETED TO INCLUDE AN ADVANCED PRACTICE NURSE AND A PHYSICIAN 1314 ASSISTANT.

15 (D) IF THE APPLICATION OF SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION IS 16 CONSISTENT WITH THE SCOPE OF PRACTICE OF THE ADVANCED PRACTICE 17 NURSE OR PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT, ADDITIONAL AUTHORIZATION FROM A UNIT 18 TO ENDORSE A DOCUMENT UNDER THE APPLICATION OF SUBSECTION (C) OF 19 THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE REQUIRED.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be 21 construed to apply retroactively and shall be applied to and interpreted to affect all 22 documents prepared or written in accordance with State law before the effective date 23 of this Act.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
