- 1 (A) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FINDS THAT THE COMMISSION IS NOT IN 2 COMPLIANCE WITH THE MINORITY BUSINESS ENTERPRISE REQUIREMENTS OF 3 THIS SUBTITLE. THERE IS A WSSC PROCUREMENT OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE. 4 (B) **(1)** 5 **(2)** (I)THE COMMITTEE CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING 6 **MEMBERS:** 7 ONE MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF 1. 8 THE SENATE: 9 2. ONE MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES; 10 11 3. ONE MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY; AND 12 13 4. - SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before January 1, 2013, the WSSC Procurement Oversight Committee shall report to the Montgomery County and Prince George's County Senate and House delegations to the Maryland General Assembly, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, on the status of minority business enterprise participation in procurements for the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2011.
