## 1 AN ACT concerning

# 2 Property Tax Credit – Elderly, Veterans, and Returning Residents (Welcome Home, Stay at Home Act)

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City and the 5 governing body of a county or municipal corporation to provide a property tax credit 6 against the county or municipal corporation property tax imposed on the dwelling of 7 certain individuals who are elderly, veterans, or recently returned to the State; 8 providing for the amount and duration of the tax credit; authorizing the Mayor and 9 City Council of Baltimore City and the governing body of a county or municipal 10 corporation to provide for certain matters relating to the tax credit; defining certain terms; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to a property 11 tax credit for certain individuals who are elderly, veterans, or recently returned to 12 the State. 13

- 5 (2) "DWELLING" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 9–105 OF THIS

- 7 (3) "ELIGIBLE INDIVIDUAL" MEANS:
- 8 (I) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS AT LEAST 65 YEARS OLD AND HAS

- 10 (II) A RETIRED MEMBER OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE
