

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 4 Article - Economic Development 5 6 13-601. 7 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated. "Commissioners" means the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert 8 (b) County, Charles County, or St. Mary's County, respectively. 9 "Council" means the Tri-County Council for Southern Maryland. 10 (c) 11 (d) "Executive Director" means the Executive Director of the Council. 12(e) "Plan" means a regional plan that the Council prepares for the region. "Region" means Calvert, Charles, and St. Mary's counties. 13 (f) 14 13-611. 15 The State and Calvert, Charles, and St. Mary's counties may jointly finance the Council and its activities. 16 17 The State may provide financial support to the Council to assist in 18 carrying out the activities of the Council. 19 On or before August 1 of each year, the Council shall submit its 20 proposed work programs and operating budget for the following fiscal year to the 21Department. 22(ii) The submission shall include supporting schedules to show how 23the budget is financed, and to provide for review and recommendations. 24(iii) After review, the Department shall forward the submission and any recommendations to the Department of Budget and Management for consideration. 2526 The Governor shall include in the State budget for the following fiscal year an appropriation to partially support the Council. 27

THEREAFTER, THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN

FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR

\$900,000 TO THE COUNCIL FROM THE CIGARETTE

- RESTITUTION FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER § 7-317 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND 1 2 PROCUREMENT ARTICLE. THE COUNCIL SHALL USE FUNDS APPROPRIATED 3 FROM THE CIGARETTE RESTITUTION FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING THE 4 ACTIVITIES OF THE SOUTHERN MARYLAND AGRICULTURAL DEVELOPMENT 5 COMMISSION. 6 7 3. - 28 **(4)** any other program that is funded with money from the Cigarette 29 Restitution Fund established under § 7–317 of this title.

1	(f) (1) The Cigarette Restitution Fund shall be used to fund:
2 3	(i) the Tobacco Use Prevention and Cessation Program established under Title 13, Subtitle 10 of the Health – General Article;
4 5	(ii) the Cancer Prevention, Education, Screening, and Treatment Program established under Title 13, Subtitle 11 of the Health – General Article; [and]
6 7 8	(iii) THE ACTIVITIES OF THE SOUTHERN MARYLAND AGRICULTURAL DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 13–611 OF THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ARTICLE; AND
9	(IV) other programs that serve the following purposes:
10 11	1. reduction of the use of tobacco products by individuals under the age of 21 years;
12 13 14 15	2. implementation of the Southern Maryland Regional Strategy–Action Plan for Agriculture adopted by the Tri–County Council for Southern Maryland with an emphasis on alternative crop uses for agricultural land now used for growing tobacco;
16 17 18	3. public and school education campaigns to decrease tobacco use with initial emphasis on areas targeted by tobacco manufacturers in marketing and promoting cigarette and tobacco products;
19	4. smoking cessation programs;
20	5. enforcement of the laws regarding tobacco sales;
21 22	6. the purposes of the Maryland Health Care Foundation under Title 20, Subtitle 5 of the Health – General Article;
23 24 25	7. primary health care in rural areas of the State and areas targeted by tobacco manufacturers in marketing and promoting cigarette and tobacco products;
26 27 28	8. prevention, treatment, and research concerning cancer, heart disease, lung disease, tobacco product use, and tobacco control, including operating costs and related capital projects;
29	9. substance abuse treatment and prevention programs; and
30	10. any other public purpose.
31	(2) The provisions of this subsection may not be construed to affect the

Governor's powers with respect to a request for an appropriation in the annual budget bill.

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SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 2 $\,$ 1, 2022.
