- FOR the purpose of requiring that electric vehicles registered in the Commonwealth of Virginia that qualify for the use of high occupancy vehicle (HOV) lanes in Virginia be allowed to use HOV lanes in Maryland; making this Act subject to a certain contingency; and generally relating to electric vehicles and HOV lanes.
- 8 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 9 MARYLAND, That:
- 10 (a) Electric vehicles registered in the Commonwealth of Virginia that qualify 11 for the use of high occupancy vehicle (HOV) lanes in Virginia shall be allowed to use 12 HOV lanes in Maryland.
- 13 (b) The State Highway Administration shall adopt regulations to carry out 14 this Act.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1 of this Act may not take effect until a similar Act is passed in the Commonwealth of Virginia to allow electric vehicles registered in Maryland that qualify for the use of HOV lanes in Maryland to use HOV lanes in Virginia; and upon passage of the similar Act by the Commonwealth of Virginia, the Governor of the State of Maryland shall issue a proclamation declaring this Act valid and effective and shall forward a copy of the proclamation to the Executive Director of the Department of Legislative Services.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to Section 2 of this Act, this Act shall take effect October 1, 2012.
