17 (b) (31) IF PROVIDERS OTHERWISE MEET THE FEDERAL AND STATE 18 REQUIREMENTS FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE PROGRAM OF ALL-INCLUSIVE CARE 19 FOR THE ELDERLY ("PACE"), THE DEPARTMENT MAY NOT LIMIT THE NUMBER OF 20 PROGRAM OF ALL-INCLUSIVE CARE FOR THE ELDERLY ("PACE") PROVIDERS 21 THAT OPERATE IN THE STATE.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 23 October 1, 2018.
