14	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

PER PUPIL FUNDING AMOUNT SHALL BE CALCULATED USING THE HIGHER OF:

1	1. THE JANUARY 1, 2019, ENROLLMENT; OR
2	2. THE JANUARY 1, 2023, ENROLLMENT.
3	(II) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024, FOR PROVIDERS IN THE PROGRAM
4	THAT BEGAN PROVIDING CARE TO CHILDREN AFTER MARCH 5, 2020, THE PER PUPIL
5	FUNDING AMOUNT SHALL BE CALCULATED USING THE JANUARY 1, 2023,
6	ENROLLMENT.
7	(3) BEGINNING IN FISCAL YEAR 2025 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR
8	THEREAFTER, THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCREASE THE PER PUPIL FUNDING AMOUNT
9	UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION BY THE LESSER OF:
0	(I) THE CONSUMER PRICE INDEX FOR ALL URBAN
