A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Anne Arundel County – Board of Education – Selection of Members

3 FOR the purpose of establishing a procedure for the election and appointment of certain 4 members of the Anne Arundel County Board of Education; repealing certain $\mathbf{5}$ provisions governing the appointment of all members of the county board; 6 establishing the composition of the county board; providing for the qualifications, terms of offices, and the filling of a vacancy of certain members of the county board; 7 8 repealing certain provisions relating to the retention election of certain appointed 9 members of the county board; requiring the County Executive of Anne Arundel County and the Governor to appoint certain members of the School Board 10 11 Nominating Commission of Anne Arundel County; requiring the elected members of 12the county board to reside in, be a registered voter in, and be elected from certain 13 districts; specifying that a member may not be elected or appointed to serve for more 14than a certain number of terms; providing for the removal of, and hearings and 15appeal procedures for, certain members of the county board; altering the amount of 16 compensation for certain members of the county board; providing for the termination 17of terms of the appointed members of the county board; and generally relating to the 18 election and appointment of members of the Anne Arundel County Board of 19Education.

[(f)] (G) An individual subject to the authority of the county board may not serve as a member of the county board. At the time of filing a certificate of candidacy for election to a county board, a person shall certify to the local board of supervisors of elections whether or not he is subject to the authority of the county board. The Governor shall not issue a commission of election to a person who has certified affirmatively and who is elected to a county board until the member-elect offers proof that he is no longer subject to the authority of the county board.

[(g)] (H) The election of the county boards shall be held as provided in Subtitles
 2 through 14 of this title and the Election Law Article.

25 Arundel County shall appoint a member to succeed that member to serve for a term of 4
26 years beginning on December 3, 2018, until a successor is appointed and qualifies; and

(3) the term of the member whose term is scheduled to expire on June 30,
2019, shall expire at the end of December 1, 2019, and the County Executive of Anne
Arundel County shall appoint a member to succeed that member to serve for a term of 4
years beginning on December 2, 2019, until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

(b) The terms of the five members appointed from legislative districts 30, 31, 32, 32, 33, and for that portion of legislative district 21 that lies within Anne Arundel County, or 33 their successors, who are in office on July 1, 2018, shall terminate at the end of December 34 2, 2018, and the members elected from the councilmanic districts in Anne Arundel County 35 at the general election in November 2018, shall succeed those appointed members and serve

1 for a term of 4 years beginning on December 3, 2018, until a successor is elected and 2 qualifies.

3 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the initial elected members 4 of the Anne Arundel County Board of Education as provided under this Act shall be elected 5 from the seven councilmanic districts in Anne Arundel County at the general election in 6 November 2018 and take office on December 3, 2018.

SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
 1, 2015.
