17(A) WITHIN 24 HOURS AFTER A DISCOVERY THAT AN INDIVIDUAL UNDER A 18 GUARDIANSHIP THE DEPARTMENT ADMINISTERED BY \mathbf{IS} MISSING. THE 19 DEPARTMENT AND THE APPROPRIATE LOCAL DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES 20SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY CONTAINING 21ANY INFORMATION THE DEPARTMENT HAS OR REASONABLY COULD OBTAIN THAT 22WOULD ASSIST IN LOCATING THE INDIVIDUAL, INCLUDING:
