- 16 (c) In CALVERT COUNTY, Carroll County, Charles County, Harford County, and
- Washington County, a person may not stand in a roadway, median divider, or intersection
- 18 to solicit money or donations of any kind from the occupant of a vehicle.
- 19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 20 October 1, 2024.
