BY adding to Article - Public Safety Section 12–205 Annotated Code of Maryland (2018 Replacement Volume and 2020 Supplement) SECTION 1. - 4 (D) THE BUILDER OR BUILDER'S AGENT SHALL GIVE TO EACH BUYER OR 5 PROSPECTIVE BUYER:
- 6 (1) NOTICE OF THE OPTIONS LISTED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS 7 SECTION; AND
- 8 (2) SPECIFIC INFORMATION ABOUT ANY AVAILABLE REBATE 9 PROGRAMS RELATED TO THE PURCHASE OR INSTALLATION OF ELECTRIC VEHICLE 10 CHARGING STATIONS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect on or application to any new construction for which a building permit is issued before the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 October 1, 2021.
