- 18 (A) In granting a decree of absolute divorce OR ON MOTION OF A PARTY FILED
- 19 WITHIN 18 MONTHS AFTER A FINAL DECREE OF ABSOLUTE DIVORCE IS ENTERED, the
- 20 court shall change the name of [a] THE REQUESTING party to either the name given the
- 21party at birth or any other former name the party wishes to use if:
 - (1) the party took a new name on marriage and no longer wishes to use it;
- 23 (2)the party asks for the change of name; and



- 1 (3) the purpose of the party is not illegal, fraudulent, or immoral.
- 2 (B) The provisions of Maryland Rule 15–901 relating to an action $3\,\,$ for a change of name do not apply to a change of name under this $4\,\,$ section.
