13SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF14MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 (A) IN A PROCEEDING BEFORE AN ORPHANS' COURT, A GUARDIAN OF 18 THE PROPERTY OF A MINOR MAY PETITION THE COURT TO DEPOSIT CASH 19 BELONGING TO THE MINOR IN AN AMOUNT NOT EXCEEDING \$200,000 INTO A 20 SINGLE ACCOUNT.

(B) A DEPOSIT UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION MAY BE MADE INTO ANY TYPE OF ACCOUNT AT A FEDERALLY INSURED FINANCIAL INSTITUTION, INCLUDING A CERTIFICATE OF DEPOSIT.
