## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Statewide Information Technology Master Plan – Inclusion of Cybersecurity**  
3 **Framework – Requirement**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring that the statewide information technology master plan  
5 developed by the Secretary of Information Technology include a cybersecurity  
6 framework; requiring that the Secretary consider materials developed by the  
7 National Institute of Standards and Technology in developing or modifying the  
8 cybersecurity framework; and generally relating to the inclusion of a  
9 cybersecurity framework in the statewide information technology master plan.

10 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
11 Article – State Finance and Procurement  
12 Section 3A–304  
13 Annotated Code of Maryland  
14 (2009 Replacement Volume and 2013 Supplement)

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – State Finance and Procurement**

18 3A–304.

19 (A) The Secretary shall develop a statewide information technology master  
20 plan.

1           **(B) (1) THE STATEWIDE INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY MASTER PLAN**  
2 **DEVELOPED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION SHALL INCLUDE A**  
3 **CYBERSECURITY FRAMEWORK.**

4           **(2) IN DEVELOPING OR MODIFYING THE CYBERSECURITY**  
5 **FRAMEWORK REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE**  
6 **SECRETARY SHALL CONSIDER MATERIALS DEVELOPED BY THE NATIONAL**  
7 **INSTITUTE OF STANDARDS AND TECHNOLOGY.**

8           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
9 October 1, 2014.
