BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Local Government 4-108. A qualified voter may vote in a municipal election by absentee ballot. (a) (b) **(1)** [A] SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A municipality shall provide a procedure to vote by absentee ballot.
