- 17 (A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL:
- 18(1)MONITOR EFFLUENT DISCHARGED FROM SEWAGE TREATMENT19PLANTS; AND

20 (2) EVALUATE WHETHER THE EFFLUENT AND ANY NUTRIENTS IN THE 21 EFFLUENT IMPACTS MIDGE POPULATIONS IN THE SURROUNDING LAND AND WATER 22 AREAS, INCLUDING WHETHER THE EFFLUENT CONTRIBUTES TO THE GROWTH OF 23 PHYTOPLANKTON.



1 (B) ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2021, AND EACH YEAR THEREAFTER, THE 2 DEPARTMENT SHALL REPORT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH 3 § 2–1257 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, ON THE ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED 4 IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 October 1, 2020.
