SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO A REGISTRANT FOR WHICH THE 17 OFFENSE RESULTING IN REGISTRATION INVOLVED A VICTIM UNDER THE AGE OF 18 18 YEARS AND THE REGISTRANT WAS AT LEAST 21 YEARS OLD AT THE TIME THE 19 OFFENSE WAS COMMITTED.

- 20 (B) A REGISTRANT MAY NOT RESIDE WITHIN 1,000 FEET OF:
- 21 (1) A SCHOOL;
- 22 (2) A CHILD CARE FACILITY;
