1 (A) THERE IS AN URBAN AGRICULTURE WATER AND POWER 2 INFRASTRUCTURE GRANT PROGRAM IN THE DEPARTMENT.

3 (B) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO INCREASE THE VIABILITY OF 4 URBAN FARMING AND COMMUNITY GARDENS AND IMPROVE ACCESS TO 5 URBAN–GROWN FOODS.

7 (A) THERE IS AN URBAN AGRICULTURE WATER AND POWER 8 INFRASTRUCTURE GRANT FUND.

9 (B) THE PURPOSE OF THE FUND IS TO PROVIDE GRANTS TO URBAN 10 AGRICULTURAL PRODUCERS AND QUALIFIED NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS FOR THE 11 PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF:

12 (1) AGRICULTURE EQUIPMENT ASSOCIATED WITH WATER SUPPLY 13 AND IRRIGATION; AND

14 (2) ELECTRIC POWER ACCESS.

15 (C) THE SECRETARY SHALL ADMINISTER THE FUND.

16 (D) (1) THE FUND IS A SPECIAL, NONLAPSING FUND THAT IS NOT 17 SUBJECT TO § 7–302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.

18 (2) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL HOLD THE FUND SEPARATELY, 19 AND THE COMPTROLLER SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND.

- 20 (E) THE FUND CONSISTS OF:
- 21 (1) MONEY APPROPRIATED IN THE STATE BUDGET TO THE FUND;

22 (2) MONEY APPROPRIATED TO THE FUND UNDER § 13–209 OF THE 23 TAX – PROPERTY ARTICLE; AND

24(3)ANY OTHER MONEY FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE ACCEPTED FOR25THE BENEFIT OF THE FUND.
