1 AN ACT concerning

Agriculture – Urban Agriculture Water and Power Infrastructure Grant Program and Fund – Establishment

FOR the purpose of establishing the Urban Agriculture Water and Power Infrastructure
Grant Program in the Department of Agriculture to increase the viability of urban
farming and community gardens and improve access to urban-grown foods;
establishing the Urban Agriculture Water and Power Infrastructure Grant Fund as
a special, nonlapsing fund; and generally relating to the Urban Agriculture Water
and Power Infrastructure Grant Program and Fund.
