SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 16 (a) Any adult or minor may be adopted under this subtitle.
- 17 (b) (1) Any adult may petition a court for adoption.
- 18 (2) (I) If a petitioner is married, the petitioner's spouse shall [join in] 19 CONSENT IN WRITING TO the petition unless the spouse:
- 20 [(i)] **1.** is separated from the petitioner under a circumstance that 21 gives the petitioner a ground for annulment or divorce;

1	[(ii)] 2. is not competent to [join in] CONSENT TO the petition; or
2	[(iii)] [1.] 3. A. is a parent of the prospective adoptee; and

8 9	(c) Before a petition is filed under this subtitle, a petitioner shall move for, and a court shall order that, a case pending under Subtitle 3 of this title be closed.
10 11	(d) If the marital status of a petitioner changes before entry of an order under this subtitle, the petitioner shall amend the petition accordingly.
