BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments, Article – Labor and Employment Section 3–1301(a) Annotated Code of Maryland (2016 Replacement Volume and 2019 Supplement) BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Labor and Employment Section 3-1301(g)Annotated Code of Maryland (2016 Replacement Volume and 2019 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Labor and Employment



- 2 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 3 (g) "Family member" means:
- 4 (1) a biological child, an adopted child, a foster child, or a stepchild of the 5 employee;
- 6 (2) a child for whom the employee has legal or physical custody or 7 guardianship;
- 8 (3) a child for whom the employee stands in loco parentis, regardless of the 9 child's age;
- 10 (4) a biological parent, an adoptive parent, a foster parent, or a stepparent 11 of the employee or of the employee's spouse;
- 12 (5) the legal guardian **OR WARD** of the employee **OR OF THE EMPLOYEE'S** 13 **SPOUSE**;
- 14 (6) an individual who acted as a parent or stood in loco parentis to the 15 employee or the employee's spouse when the employee or the employee's spouse was a 16 minor;
- 17 (7) the spouse of the employee;
- 18 (8) a biological grandparent, an adopted grandparent, a foster 19 grandparent, or a stepgrandparent of the employee;
- 20 (9) a biological grandchild, an adopted grandchild, a foster grandchild, or a stepgrandchild of the employee; or
- 22 (10) a biological sibling, an adopted sibling, a foster sibling, or a stepsibling 23 of the employee.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2020.
