1 AN ACT concerning

State Personnel - Collective Bargaining - Exclusive Representative Access to New Employees

FOR the purpose of altering the type of access and the circumstances under which certain 4 $\mathbf{5}$ access to new employees by exclusive representatives is required to be permitted by 6 the State, a system institution, Morgan State University, St. Mary's College of 7 Maryland, and Baltimore City Community College; altering the period of time for 8 which an exclusive representative is required to be permitted to address certain new 9 employees under certain circumstances; requiring that an exclusive representative 10 be permitted at least a certain amount of time to meet with a new employee; 11 requiring that a certain meeting between a new employee and an exclusive 12 representative be in person; authorizing a certain exclusive representative and a new 13employee to meet with a new employee through certain video technology under certain circumstances; requiring that the State, a system institution, Morgan State 14 University, St. Mary's College of Maryland, and Baltimore City Community College 1516 encourage but not require certain new employees to meet with certain exclusive representatives; requiring that a certain notice be provided on the start date of a new 1718 employee; requiring that a certain notice be provided to certain individuals in a 19 certain manner within a certain time period and include certain information; making 20conforming changes; and generally relating to collective bargaining for State 21employees and access by an exclusive representative to new employees.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 4 $\mathbf{5}$ **Article – State Personnel and Pensions** 6 3 - 307. 7 (a)Each exclusive representative has the right to communicate with the employees that it represents. 8 9 (b) The State, a system institution, Morgan State University, St. Mary's (1)College of Maryland, and Baltimore City Community College shall permit an exclusive 10 11 representative to: 12**(I)** MEET WITH A NEW EMPLOYEE IN A BARGAINING UNIT 13**REPRESENTED BY THE EXCLUSIVE REPRESENTATIVE WITHIN THE FIRST FULL PAY** 14PERIOD OF THE NEW EMPLOYEE'S START DATE; OR attend and participate in a new employee program that includes 15**(II)** one or more employees who are in a bargaining unit represented by the exclusive 16representative, IF THE NEW EMPLOYEE PROGRAM OCCURS WITHIN 14 DAYS OF THE 1718 NEW EMPLOYEE'S START DATE. 19 (2)The new employee program in paragraph [(1)] (1)(II) of this subsection 20may be a new employee orientation, training, or other program that the State, a system 21institution, Morgan State University, St. Mary's College of Maryland, or Baltimore City 22Community College and an exclusive representative negotiate in accordance with § 3–501 23of this title. 24(3)Except as provided in paragraph [(4)] (5) of this subsection, the 25exclusive representative shall be permitted AT LEAST [20] 30 minutes to MEET WITH THE 26**NEW EMPLOYEE OR TO** collectively address all new employees in attendance during a new employee program. 2728(4) **(I)** EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS 29PARAGRAPH, A MEETING BETWEEN THE NEW EMPLOYEE AND THE EXCLUSIVE 30 **REPRESENTATIVE SHALL BE IN PERSON.** 31**(II)** AN EXCLUSIVE REPRESENTATIVE AND A NEW EMPLOYEE 32MAY CHOOSE TO MEET WITH A NEW EMPLOYEE BY VIDEO OR SIMILAR TECHNOLOGY 33 IF PUBLIC HEALTH CONCERNS NECESSITATE THAT A MEETING BE CONDUCTED 34 **REMOTELY.**

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1 [(4)] (5) The State, a system institution, Morgan State University, St. 2 Mary's College of Maryland, and Baltimore City Community College and an exclusive 3 representative may negotiate a period of time that is more than [20] **30** minutes in 4 accordance with § 3–501 of this title.

5 [(5)] (6) The State, a system institution, Morgan State University, St. 6 Mary's College of Maryland, and Baltimore City Community College:

(i) shall encourage an employee to MEET WITH THE EXCLUSIVE
 8 REPRESENTATIVE OR attend the portion of a new employee program designated for an
 9 exclusive representative to address new employees; and

(ii) may not require an employee to MEET WITH AN EXCLUSIVE
 REPRESENTATIVE OR attend the portion of a new employee program designated for an
 exclusive representative to address new employees if the employee objects to attending.

(c) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection AND SUBJECT
TO PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION, the State, a system institution, Morgan State
University, St. Mary's College of Maryland, and Baltimore City Community College shall
provide the exclusive representative at least 10 days' notice fin advance of f a new employee
program] OF THE START DATE OF A NEW EMPLOYEE.

18 (2) The State, a system institution, Morgan State University, St. Mary's 19 College of Maryland, and Baltimore City Community College may provide the exclusive 20 representative with less than 10 days' notice if there is an urgent need critical to the 21 [employer's new employee program] EMPLOYER that was not reasonably foreseeable.

22 (3) THE NOTICE REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS 23 SUBSECTION SHALL:

24(I) BE PROVIDED ELECTRONICALLY TO THE LOCAL PRESIDENT25OR UNION DESIGNEE WITHIN 24 HOURS OF THE EMPLOYEE'S FIRST CHECK-IN; AND

26(II) INCLUDE THE NEW EMPLOYEE'S NAME, AND UNIT, AND ALL27EMPLOYEE IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS, INCLUDING WORKDAY NUMBERS.

28 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 29 1, 2021.
