- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 17 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE 18 MEANINGS INDICATED.
- 19 (2) "EMPLOYER" MEANS A PERSON ENGAGED IN A BUSINESS, AN 20 INDUSTRY, A PROFESSION, A TRADE, OR ANY OTHER ENTERPRISE IN THE STATE.
- 21 (3) "EMPLOYER" INCLUDES AN AGENT, REPRESENTATIVE, OR 22 DESIGNEE OF THE EMPLOYER.



- 1 (B) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO INFORMATION RELATING TO:
- 2 (1) A SEXUAL OFFENSE UNDER TITLE 3, SUBTITLE 3 OF THE
- 3 CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE;
- 4 (2) SEXUAL ABUSE OF A MINOR UNDER § 3–602 OF THE CRIMINAL 5 LAW ARTICLE; OR
- 6 (3) ANY OFFENSE IN ANOTHER STATE OR IN A FEDERAL,
- 7 MILITARY, OR NATIVE AMERICAN TRIBAL COURT OF A CRIME THAT, IF
- 8 COMMITTED IN THIS STATE, WOULD CONSTITUTE ONE OF THE CRIMES LISTED
- 9 IN ITEMS (1) AND (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION.
- 10 (C) AN EMPLOYER MAY NOT FAIL OR REFUSE TO HIRE, DISCHARGE, OR
- 11 OTHERWISE DISCRIMINATE AGAINST ANY INDIVIDUAL WITH RESPECT TO THE
- 12 INDIVIDUAL'S COMPENSATION, TERMS, CONDITIONS, OR PRIVILEGES OF
- 13 EMPLOYMENT BECAUSE OF INFORMATION INDICATING THAT AN INDIVIDUAL
- 14 HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF A CRIMINAL OFFENSE THAT IS NOT DIRECTLY
- 15 RELATED TO EMPLOYMENT.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 17 October 1, 2011.
