1 (3) (i) "Restrictive housing" means a form of physical separation that 2 has not been requested by the inmate in which the inmate is placed in a locked room or cell 3 for approximately 22 hours or more out of a 24-hour period.

4 (ii) "Restrictive housing" includes administrative segregation and 5 disciplinary segregation.

9 (2) "RESTRICTIVE HOUSING" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 9–614 10 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

11 (3) "SERIOUS MENTAL ILLNESS" INCLUDES:

12(I) SCHIZOPHRENIA SPECTRUM AND OTHER PSYCHOTIC13 DISORDERS;

- 14 (II) BIPOLAR AND RELATED DISORDERS;
- 15 (III) MAJOR DEPRESSIVE DISORDERS;
- 16 (IV) ANXIETY DISORDERS;
- 17 (V) OBSESSIVE COMPULSIVE AND RELATED DISORDERS;
- 18 (VI) TRAUMA AND STRESSOR-RELATED DISORDERS;
- 19(VII) INTELLECTUAL DISABILITIES AND AUTISM SPECTRUM20DISORDERS;
- 21 (VIII) MAJOR NEUROCOGNITIVE DISORDERS;
- 22 (IX) PERSONALITY DISORDERS; AND

23(x) OTHER CONDITIONS RECOGNIZED AS SERIOUS MENTAL24ILLNESSES BY THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF PRISONS.

25 (B) AN INMATE OF A STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY MAY NOT BE PLACED 26 IN RESTRICTIVE HOUSING UNLESS:

1	(1) THE INMATE POSES AN IMMEDIATE AND SUBSTANTIAL RISK OF
2	PHYSICAL HARM TO THE SECURITY OF THE FACILITY, TO THE INMATE, OR TO
3	OTHERS THAT IS NOT THE RESULT OF A SERIOUS MENTAL ILLNESS;
4	(2) ALL OTHER LESS–RESTRICTIVE OPTIONS TO ADDRESS THE RISK
5	HAVE BEEN ATTEMPTED AND EXHAUSTED; AND
6	(3) THE INMATE IS IN RESTRICTIVE HOUSING ONLY FOR THE
7	MINIMUM TIME REQUIRED TO ADDRESS THE RISK, AND FOR A PERIOD OF TIME THAT
8	DOES NOT COMPROMISE THE MENTAL AND PHYSICAL HEALTH OF THE INMATE.

9	(C) FOR EACH INCIDENT WHEN RESTRICTIVE HOUSING IS USED, THE
10	FACILITY SHALL DOCUMENT THE USAGE OF RESTRICTIVE HOUSING, INCLUDING:
11	(1) THE NAME, AGE, GENDER, AND RACE OF THE INMATE SUBJECT TO
12^{-1}	RESTRICTIVE HOUSING;
13	(2) THE DATE AND TIME THE INMATE WAS PLACED IN AND RELEASED
14	FROM RESTRICTIVE HOUSING; AND
15	(3) THE REASON FOR THE CONFINEMENT, INCLUDING ATTEMPTS AT
16	LESS-RESTRICTIVE OPTIONS.

17	(D) THE RECORDS DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION,
18	EXCLUDING ANY IDENTIFYING INFORMATION, SHALL BE POSTED PROMPTLY ON THE
19	WEBSITE OF THE DEPARTMENT.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 21 October 1, 2021.
