- 1 (A) ON OR BEFORE JUNE 1, 2016, THE BALTIMORE CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT AND THE BALTIMORE COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT EACH SHALL 3 ESTABLISH A MENTAL HEALTH UNIT.
- 4 (B) A MENTAL HEALTH UNIT SHALL CONSIST OF AT LEAST SIX OFFICERS 5 WHO ARE SPECIALLY TRAINED:
- 6 (1) TO UNDERSTAND THE NEEDS OF MENTALLY ILL INDIVIDUALS; AND
- 7 (2) IN CULTURAL SENSITIVITY AND CULTURAL COMPETENCY.
- 8 (C) TRAINING FOR OFFICERS IN A MENTAL HEALTH UNIT SHALL BE
  9 DEVELOPED IN CONSULTATION WITH THE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH ADMINISTRATION
  10 IN THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before October 1, 2018, the Baltimore City Police Department and the Baltimore County Police Department shall report to the General Assembly, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, on the number of emergency calls that their mental health units responded to in 2016, 2017, and 2018, and the disposition of those calls.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2015. It shall remain effective for a period 3 years and 9 months and, at the end of June 30, 2019, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
