

- 19 (vi) acquire wireless telecommunications devices, computers, and 20 related computer equipment if used exclusively for fire protection, rescue, and ambulance 21 services; and
- 22 (vii) acquire machinery and equipment if used exclusively for fire 23 protection, rescue, and ambulance services.
