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Maryland State Parks - Foster Family Pass - Establishment

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Natural Resources to develop a certain 4 Foster Family Pass; providing that any individual who provides foster care or 5 kinship care to a minor child in the State is eligible to receive the pass; specifying 6 the period of time for which the pass is valid; providing that there is no fee for the 7 pass; requiring an individual to apply for the pass in a certain manner; providing 8 that the pass exempts certain individuals from certain State parks admissions fees 9 and authorizes certain individuals to camp overnight at certain State parks free of charge, under certain circumstances; requiring the Department of Natural 10 11 Resources to coordinate with the Department of Human Resources to establish a 12 process for verifying certain individuals' eligibility for the pass; requiring the 13 Department of Natural Resources to adopt certain regulations; defining certain 14 terms; and generally relating to the establishment of a Foster Family Pass.

- 20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 21 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 22 Article Natural Resources
- 23 **5–1011.**
- 24 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
- 25 INDICATED.

- 1 (2) "FOSTER CARE" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 5–501 OF THE 2 FAMILY LAW ARTICLE.
- 3 (3) "HOLDER" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HOLDS A PASS ISSUED BY 4 THE DEPARTMENT UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 5 (4) "KINSHIP CARE" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 5–501 OF THE 6 FAMILY LAW ARTICLE.
- 7 (5) "PASS" MEANS THE FOSTER FAMILY PASS ESTABLISHED UNDER 8 THIS SECTION.
- 9 (B) (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEVELOP A FOSTER FAMILY PASS.
- 10 (2) ANY INDIVIDUAL WHO PROVIDES FOSTER CARE OR KINSHIP CARE 11 TO A MINOR CHILD IN THE STATE IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE THE PASS.
- 12 (3) THE PASS SHALL BE VALID FOR A PERIOD DETERMINED BY THE 13 DEPARTMENT, WHICH MAY NOT BE LESS THAN 1 YEAR.
- 14 (4) THERE IS NO FEE FOR THE PASS.
- 15 (C) TO APPLY FOR THE PASS, AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL SUBMIT AN 16 APPLICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT IN THE FORM THAT THE DEPARTMENT 17 REQUIRES.
- 18 **(D)** WHEN PRESENTED BY AN ELIGIBLE HOLDER ACCOMPANIED BY A MINOR 19 CHILD RECEIVING FOSTER CARE OR KINSHIP CARE FROM THE HOLDER, THE PASS:
- 20 (1) EXEMPTS THE HOLDER AND MEMBERS OF THE HOLDER'S 21 HOUSEHOLD FROM STATE PARKS ADMISSIONS FEES; AND
- 22 (2) AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER AND MEMBERS OF THE HOLDER'S HOUSEHOLD TO CAMP OVERNIGHT IN ANY STATE PARK FREE OF CHARGE.
- 24 (E) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL:
- 25 (1) COORDINATE WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES 26 TO ESTABLISH A PROCESS FOR VERIFYING THE ELIGIBILITY OF INDIVIDUALS WHO
- 27 APPLY FOR THE PASS; AND
- 28 (2) ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2017.
